

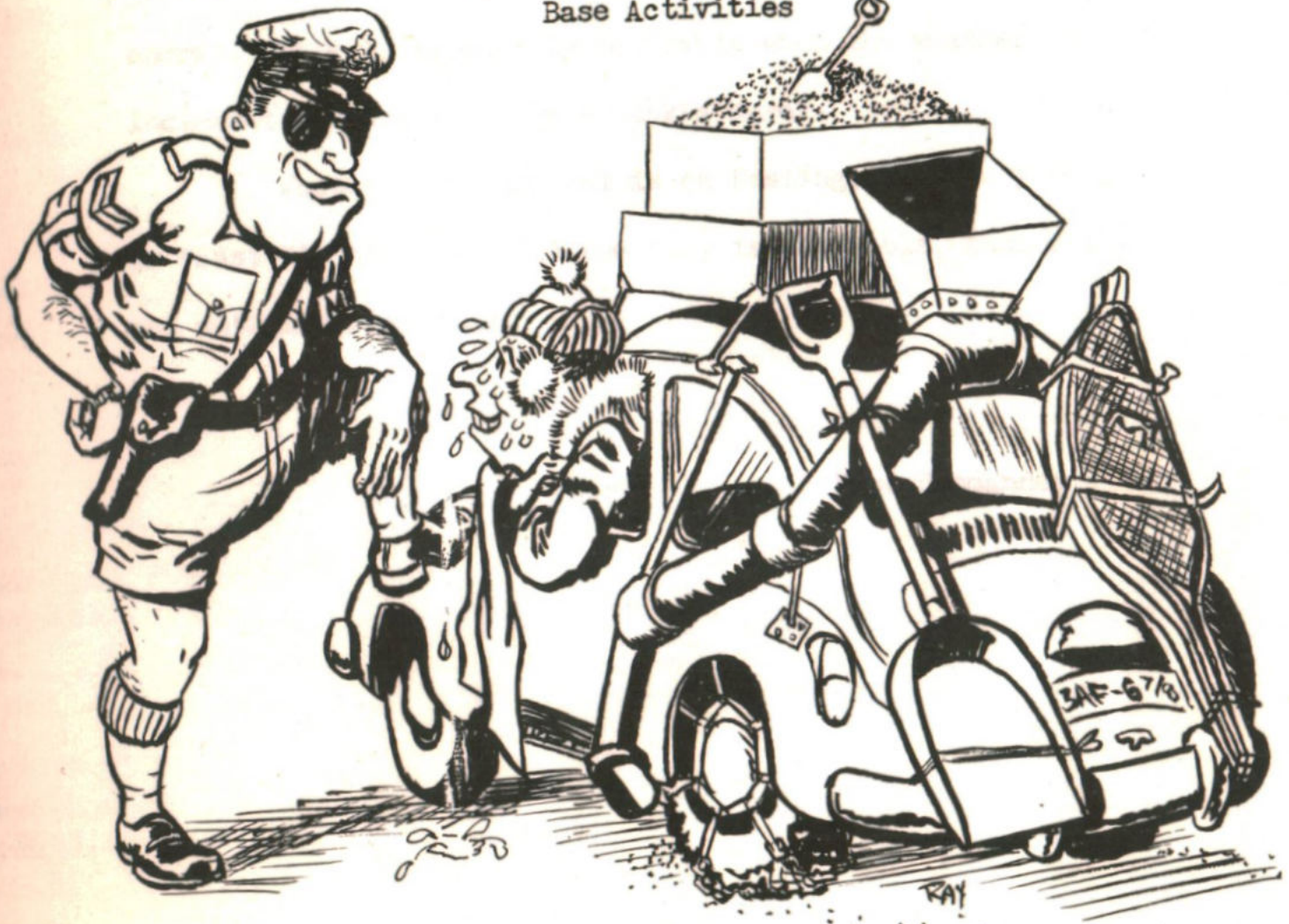

BASE HISTORY AND PRESENT STATUS

Post World War II requirements for a large "Air Weapons Range" and associated "Air Base" resulted in the building of "Royal Canadian Air Force Station Cold Lake" and the range in the early 1950s. The station opened in March 1954 as the home of #3 ALL WEATHER (FIGHTER) Operational Training Unit and a detachment of the "Central Experimental and Proving Establishment". The latter unit became - #448 Aerospace Engineering Test Establishment in the Combined Forces Program. In late 1961 a requirement to train CF-104 STARFIGHTER crews brought 417 STRIKE/RECCE (OPERATIONAL TRAINING SQUADRON) in 3 AW(F) OTU's place and 1968 saw the start of the CF-5 operational training by 434 Squadron. In addition, #42 Radar Squadron, a Satellite Tracking Unit, Medical & Dental Units, #742 Communication Squadron and #10 Field Technical Training Unit call Canadian Forces Base Cold Lake - "HOME".
