EDITORS COMMENTARY

Voxair's front page is symbolic of everything in the Red River Valley Manitoba in recent weeks — everything has been surrounded by water.

Team work and understanding have been the key words during the 1979 flood plaguing residence of many towns such as Emerson, Letellier, St. Jean Baptiste, Morris, Brunkild, St. Agathe, St. Adolphe and many more.

It has indeed been water, water everywhere, but nowhere has the spirit of these hardy Manitoba people been dampened, and the teamwork between civilian volunteers and the Canadian Forces has been tremendous. All concerned have one goal, to "defeat" the ever-present enemy, flood waters.

Men from the 2nd Battalion Princess Patricia's Canadian Light Infantry have worked on a 24-hour basis in several locations on dike patrol and maintenance and in general to co-operate with the Emergency Measures Organization, Provincial Government authorities, RCMP and the various Municipal authorities to ensure the safety of those communities in danger.

One would be in error not to comment on such situations as the cheerful, optimistic approach taken by the citizens and the civilian volunteers who worked so hard at Brunkild filling sandbags; the humorous, dedicated women in the town of Emerson who worked constantly in their recreation center to, "be with their men"; or the quiet

unassuming people at St. Jean Baptiste for whom it has been "almost business as usual".

This issue gives readers a pictorial story of the 1979 floods in Manitoba as seen through the eyes of the Voxair editor and the cameras of WO Jack Casey of the DND Office of Information in Winnipeg and CAPT A.J. Currie of CFB Winnipeg. Obviously not every incident or detail is recorded in this issue, but there is enough to give an all-round view of things. Hopefully, the reader will grasp the immensity of Operation Bolster, the code name given the Canadian Forces 1979 flood activities in Manitoba.

Such things as the untiring, relentless flying done by 408 and 447, Squadrons from Edmonton with

their Chinook, Huey, and Kiowa helicopters. These people never seemed to tire, to complain, nor to fail. Their dedication to providing excellent support to all aspects of the flood fight cannot go unrecognized. Nor can the support of 3 CFFTS from Portage La Prairie and Base Rescue from CFB Moose Jaw. And, of course, let us not forget the maintainers of CFB Winnipeg's BAMEO section. There are, of course, many more who contributed.

While our soldiers from 2PPCLI Winnipeg, 2 Combat Engineer Regiment Chilliwack, and Militia from Winnipeg have provided round-the-clock vigilance and assistance on the ground and in the water, our men in the helicopters ensured transport and supply lines

were always open.

Operation Bolster has been a good example of military participation in supporting our civilian friends in a dangerous situation. The expertise of the staff at Prairie Regional operations coupled with EMO to make an effective team.

Voxair extends to all who actively worked in combatting the 1979 flood, and those who actively supported the workers, a great big "WELL-DONE".

For those who's tasks are now finished, I am sure thousands say, "thank-you". For the thousands who now must endure the clean-up, Voxair can only wish you well — and do not lose spirit. — Editor

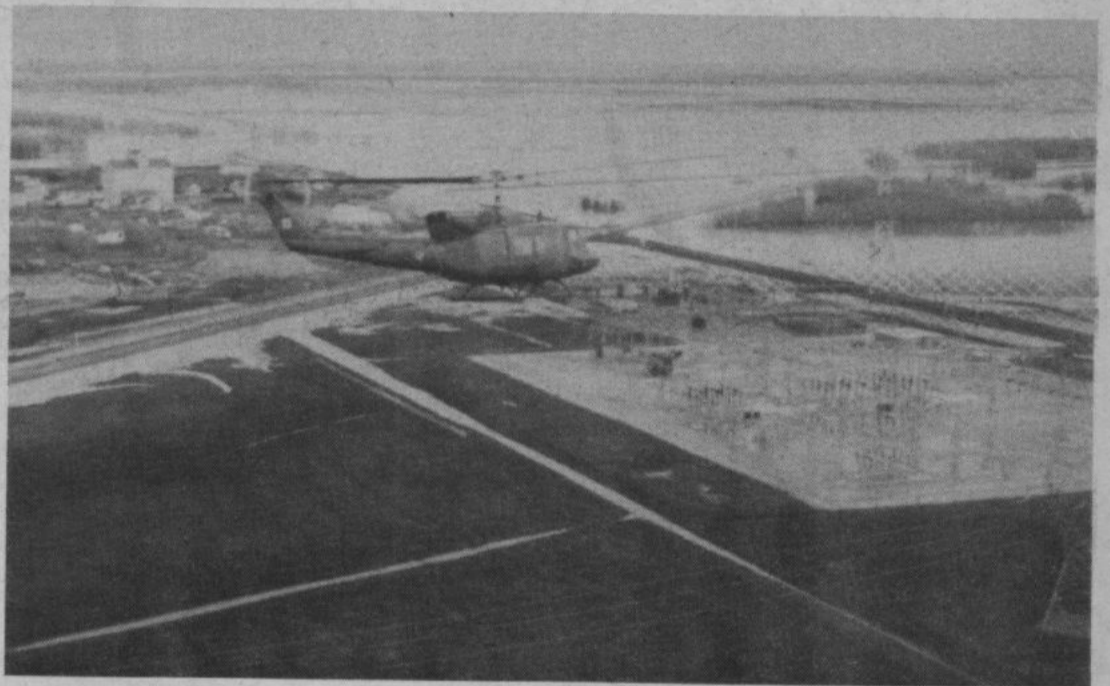

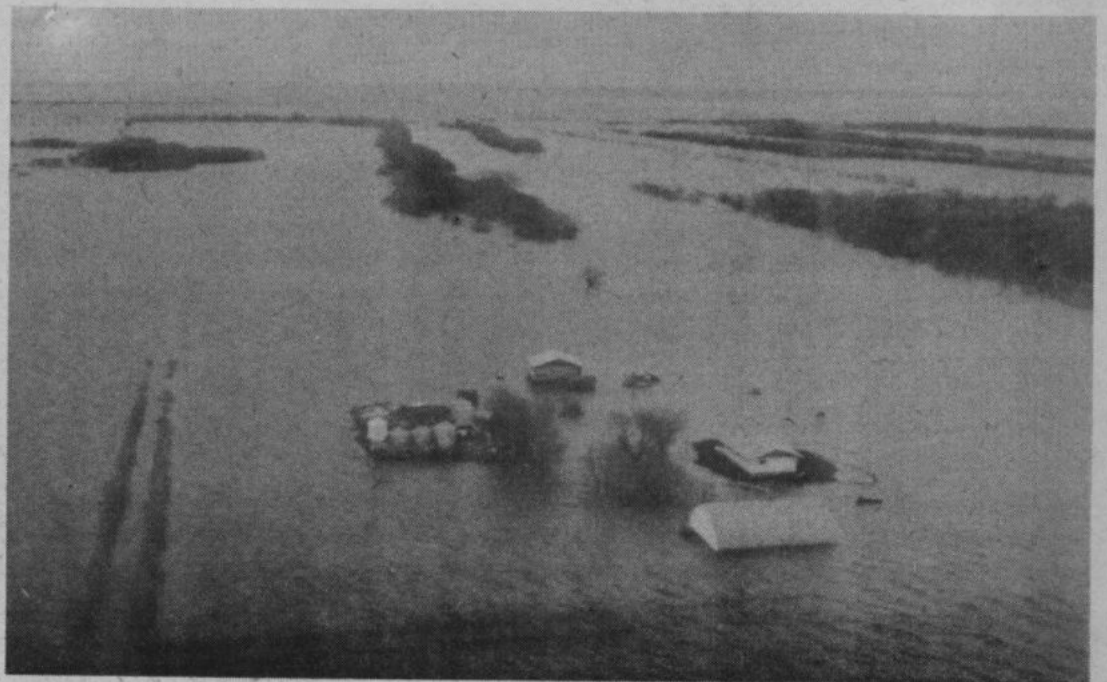

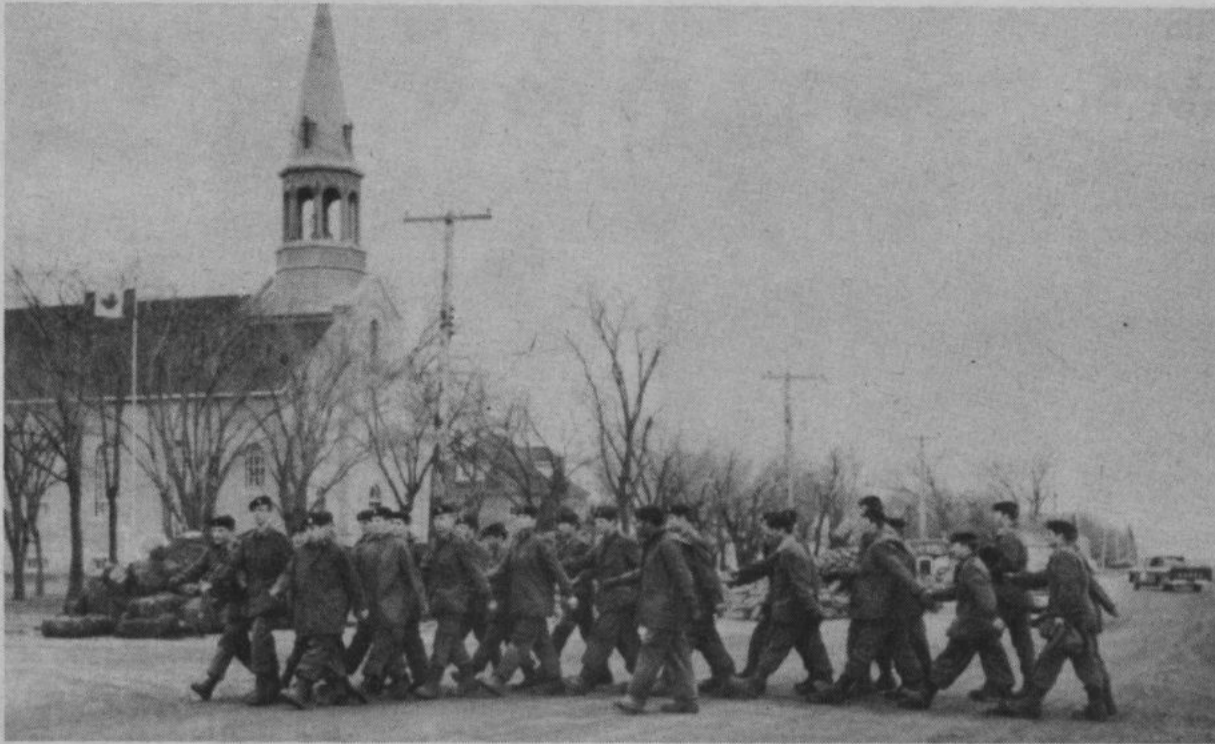

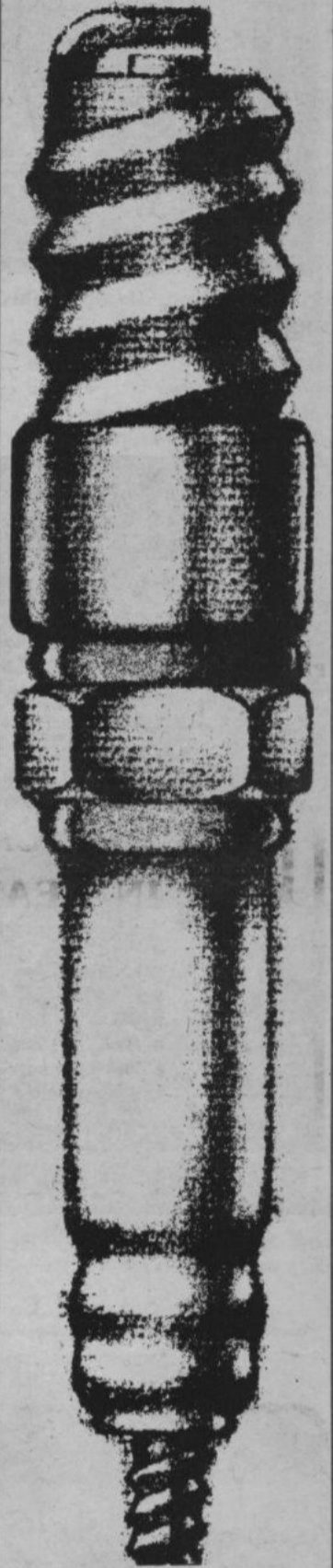

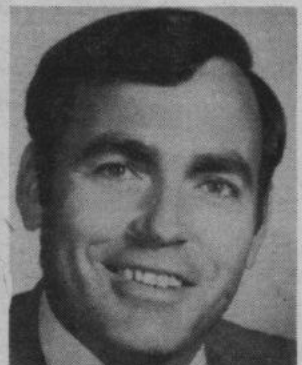

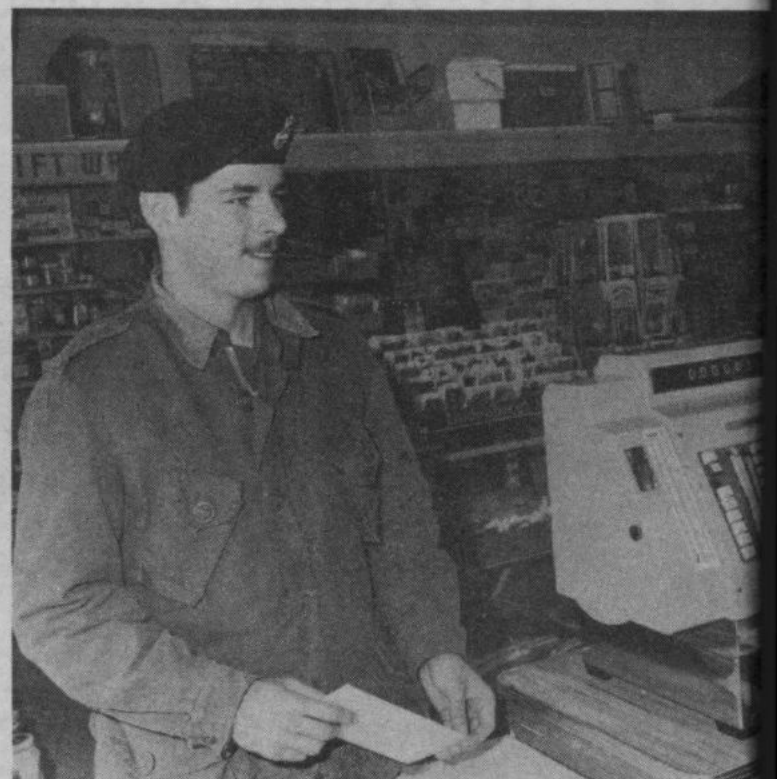

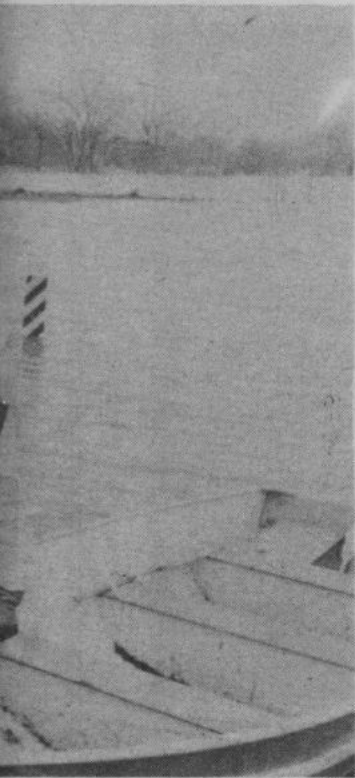

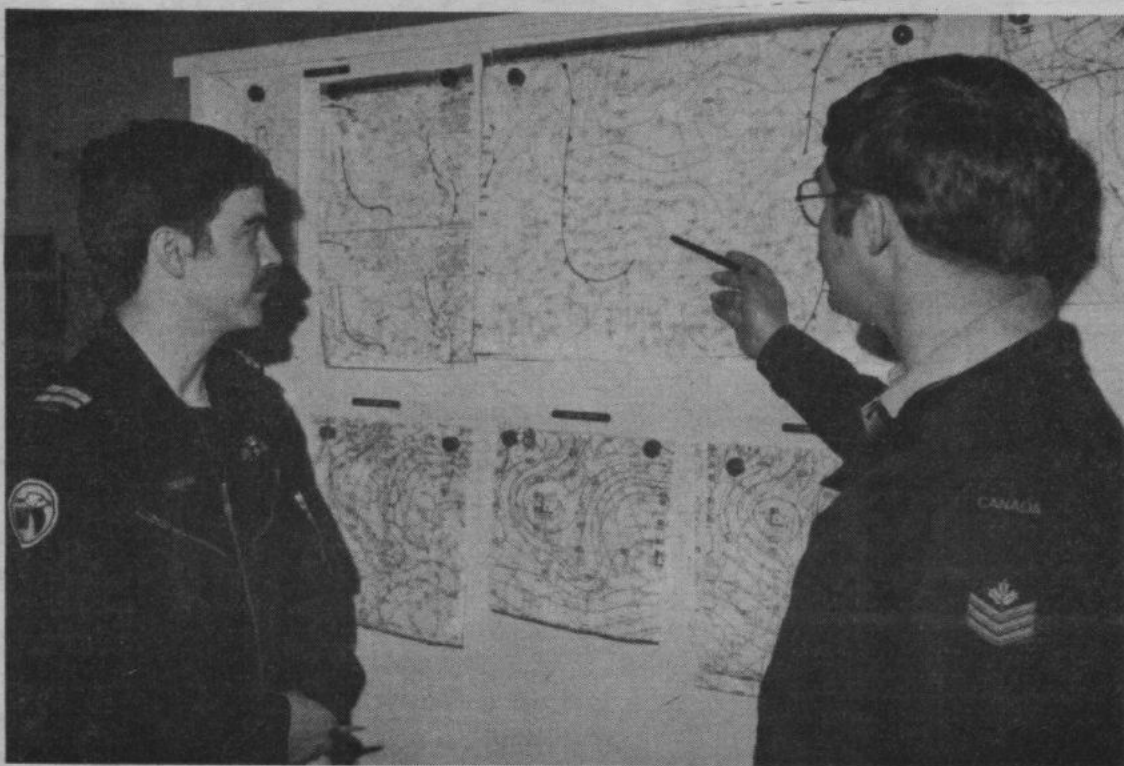

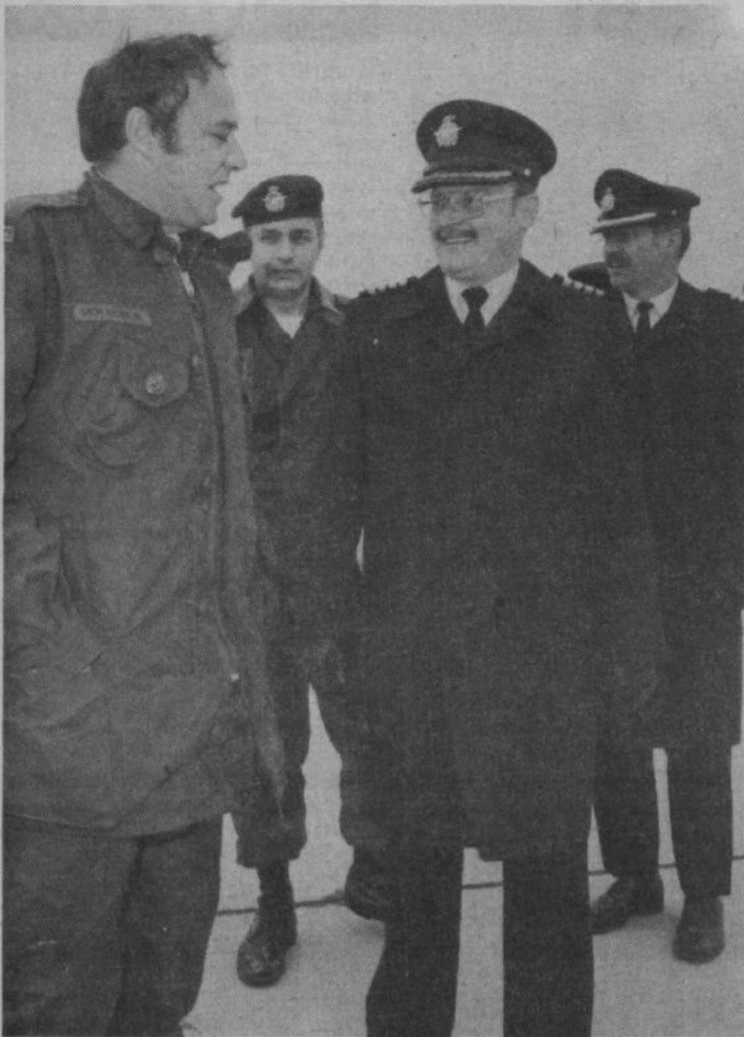

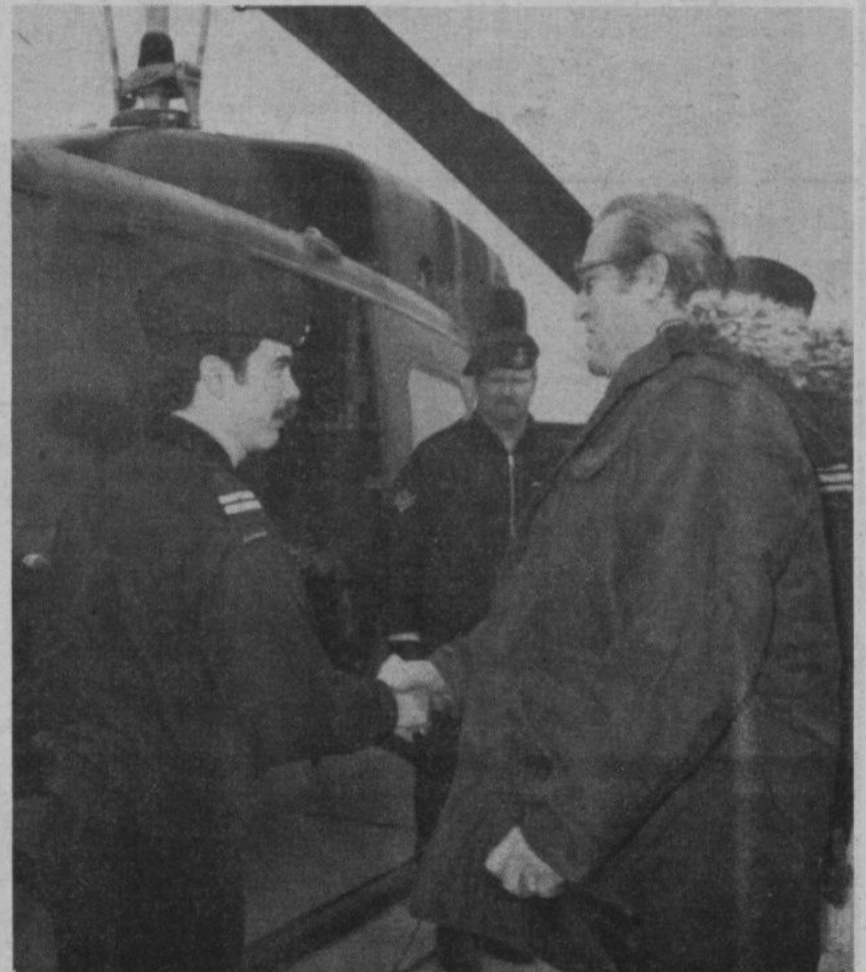
